## Guide for Riders and Walkers and Sponsor Form

Help save our beautiful heritage by cycling or walking from Church to Church to raise money for the Church of your choice. Half the money raised will be returned direct to the Churches, while the other half, plus any Gift Aid shown on the Sponsor Form, will go to the Churches via grants from the Lincolnshire Churches Trust. Hundreds of churches have benefited from grants given by the Trust since its foundation in 1952.

**GIFT AID makes a big difference to the Trust - worth an extra 25p for every £1**

### How It Works

1. Use the form overleaf to find Sponsors who will sponsor you for each manned Church visited by you either by cycling, walking or horse riding. Churches are manned between 10am and 6pm on Saturday 11th September.
2. Start from any of the listed manned Churches or Chapels participating in the event and visit any others on the list, crossing Deanery boundaries if you wish.
3. Write the name and address of the Parish organiser, or ask this to be filled in when you start the event. Have your first church's name entered

and initialled with the time of your visit. At each Church or Chapel you visit, ask for the time to be entered and the name of the church to be written alongside. You will find this on the back page.

4. After the event collect all money due from Sponsors and pass it, along with the signed Sponsor form, to your Parish Organiser no later than Friday 15th October 2021.
5. Please remember; cyclists should ride in single file, walkers should walk on the right to face oncoming traffic if there is no footpath, always observe the Highway code, check your bicycle brakes before the event for safety, and please wear your Badge prominently.
6. It is a condition of entry that save to the extent required by law, the Trustees of the Lincolnshire Churches Trust accept no liability in respect of death or injury sustained by any participant on the Ride & Stride.
